

# ANNUAL REPORT

*Chancellor*:—His Excellency Dr. Harendracóomar Mookerjee, M.A., Ph.D. on his assumption of office as the Governor of West Bengal, became the Chancellor of the University with effect from 1st November, 1951. This appointment was particularly gratifying to the University, because His Excellency is a distinguished alumnus of the University and was long connected with it as a University Inspector of Colleges, a Professor of English and as the first Secretary to the Post-Graduate Council in Arts.

*The Calcutta University Act, 1951*:—The year 1951 saw some eventful changes in the shape of the University. The Calcutta University Act, 1951, passed by the West Bengal Legislature, contemplates many radical changes in the shape and constitution of the University. The West Bengal Secondary Education Act also has taken away the control of the University over about 1100 recognised H. E. Schools and thus has curtailed its jurisdiction. The University will no longer hold its Matriculation Examination for students sent up by schools. The West Bengal Secondary Education Board constituted under the Act is functioning and all matters relating to Schools and School Final Examination are being dealt with by the Board. The Act provides for compensation to the University by Government for the loss of income of the University as a result of this change. The amount of compensation will be determined by a Tribunal as provided in the Act on the basis of the last 3 years' actual income and expenditure.

*Vice-Chancellor*:—The Hon'ble Justice Sri Sambhunath Banerjee, M.Sc., LL.B., Barrister-at-Law, was appointed first Vice-Chancellor of the University during the continuance of his term as Vice-Chancellor under the old Act, under sub-section (1) of Section 52 of the Calcutta University Act, 1951, with effect from 15th September, 1951.
