Sub- Participation of NSS Volunteers in Adventure Camp at Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Mountaineering and Allied Sports, Manali (Himachal Pradesh) from 25th November- 4th December, 2023- regarding

Sir,

With reference to the letter no F.No. P.42-1/NSS/DTE/2022/23/1694-1747 dated 8.11.2023 received from the Directorate of NSS, New Delhi it is to inform you that Ministry of Youth Affair & Sports, Govt. of India has taken initiative to organize Adventure Camps for the year 2023-2024 in different batches from November 2023 to February 2024 at Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Mountaineering and Allied Sports, Himachal Pradesh. In this connection an **Adventure Camp** is going to be held at **Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Mountaineering and Allied Sports, Manali (Himachal Pradesh) from 25th November- 4th December, 2023.**

Therefore, you are requested to depute NSS volunteers as per the allocation mentioned below from your jurisdiction to participate in the above said camp. During the selection of NSS volunteers for Adventure Camp following instructions mentioned below strictly be adhered. A selection committee should be constituted under the chairmanship of Programme Coordinator. The Programme Coordinator will be solely responsible for entire selection process.

Guidelines for selection of NSS volunteers for Adventure Camp:

1. The NSS volunteers selected for this camp should be physically fit and be able to undergo hard adventurous activities. (Every NSS volunteers must submit medical fitness certificate from recognized medical Officer)
2. Every NSS volunteers must carry an indemnity bond form.
3. Every NSS Volunteers must carry a Bonafide NSS volunteership certificate.
4. Every NSS volunteers must carry sufficient woolen Garments (minimum one pull over/ Sweater and Trekking shoes)

5. The NSS volunteers who have already attended any National Level Adventure Programme should not be repeated.
6. The NSS Volunteers selected must be from Graduation level and not from +2 School level.
7. The maximum number of selected NSS volunteers should not be more than two from one Institution.
8. Selection will be done in consultation with the State Govt.
9. A pair of track-suit, water bottle, sports shoes with socks will also be provided by this Office to all the NSS volunteers/Programme Officer.
10. Programme Coordinator will constitute a selection committee for selection of NSS volunteers in this adventure Camp.

All participants will be provided free boarding & lodging by the Organizers and travel cost of Second class/Sleeper Class by train (Direct and Telescopic ticket) or by ordinary bus (State Transport Rate) paid for the shortest route from the university / College to Manali, Himachal Pradesh will be reimbursed by the Regional Directorate of NSS Kolkata on submission of TA Form in prescribed Proforma along with ticket in original (Original Bill/Original Tickets) and also Photocopy of personal bank account having account details. In addition to this, Track Suit, Water Bottle, Sports Shoes with Socks will also be provided to the NSS volunteers/Programme Officer by this office after receiving the list of participants in prescribed proforma. Necessary forms, instructions, and other information regarding the camp are attached herewith for kind perusal at your end. Contingent Leader will be provided Honorarium as per the allocation of Govt. Budget.

In this regard, the Contingent leaders are directed to book rail ticket (Second Class/Sleeper Class) of all participants up to Ambala Cant./Chandigarh/Delhi and travel from Ambala Cant. /Chandigarh/Delhi to Manali (Himachal Pradesh) by ordinary Bus. The same route should be followed for the return journey and rail ticket (Second Class/Sleeper Class) of all participants up to Howrah/Sealdah should also be booked by the Contingent Leaders. Travel by Taxi or AC & Sleeper Bus to and fro Ambala Cant./Chandigarh/Delhi will not be reimbursed. All the participants have to report by morning of 25th November, 2023 to the organizers and they can leave the camp on 4th December, 2023 evening onwards after the completion of the programme.

Further, all the NSS volunteers have to carry necessary documents (Volunteership certificate, Indemnity bond, medical fitness certificates, College Id Card, Three Color Passport photos, etc. along with traditional attires & State banner of the contingent for display along with their daily routine toiletry items and necessary medicines with them during the camp. During the camp the temperature will be near about 2-3 degree therefore all the participants are asked to carry sufficient woolen clothes with jackets, woolen caps etc., The Participants should not carry any costly articles and ornaments with them.

In this connection, you are requested to send the name of NSS volunteers to this Office within 15th **November, 2023** positively in the prescribed format mentioned in the letter for participation in the above said Adventure Camp.

How to reach Manali:

- (i) The nearest railhead is Ambala/Chandigarh. From Ambala and Chandigarh Manali is 360 km respectively approx. 8-10 hours' journey. Approx. bus fare is Rs.655/-
- (ii) Manali is also accessible from Delhi (overnight bus journey) and is approx. 575 km, Bus journey takes 15-17 hours. After every half an hour, bus ply from ISBT, Kashmiri Gate, between 4.30 p.m. to 8.30 p.m. Bus fare is Rs. 900/-.
