The department's students were the prime motivators and organisers of the seminar. Student participants from the department formed sixteen groups and presented their research papers. The total number of teacher and student participants was 71.



The History Department organised an online extension lecture on *Bapu-Subhash Samporko: Pita-Putro Naki Pratwidandi? Bangalir Gujober Rajnitir Koyek Doshok* on 8th October 2021, at 11 am. The talk, which was in the form of a presentation followed by a Q&A session, was delivered by Shri Debraj Ghatak, Project Fellow, Jadavpur University. Homing in on one such case – the case of recruiter Buldeo from 1870s Allahabad – this talk sought to illustrate how kidnapping became a familiar mode of indentured labour recruitment in nineteenth-century India.
