Minutes of the meeting dated 13.07.2017: (1) The meeting was chaired by the Head, Department of Chemistry. (2) It has been unanimously agreed upon that the SMP has to be initiated in the department. All the faculty members came forward to play the role of a mentor. (3) The members present in the meeting discussed the role of the mentor. It was agreed upon by all present in the meeting that the Faculty mentor will be entrusted with the following (a) The Faculty mentors shall oversee the day-to-day functioning of the SMP. For this, they must keep in regular touch with the mentees to ensure that the primary objective of the (b) The SMP body should interact and share their experiences once in a month in the form of a departmental meeting and exchange their views. (c) The Faculty mentor shall counsel the students with difficulty in adjusting to the environment. (d) The Faculty mentors are to record their findings in a Mentor's Diary. (e) The Faculty mentors, if required, are to schedule face to face counselling with their mentees. (f) The Faculty mentor bring to notice of the department any complex situation that might (4) It has also been agreed upon that a mentor-mentee distribution will be prepared by the Head for the UG Semester-1 students and will be circulated in the department for the perusal of all concerned. A copy of the same will also be displayed on the departmental notice display board. (5) It was further stressed that the success of the SMP will depend on the involvement of the student mentors in the program. It was unanimously agreed upon that student mentors will be selected based on their performance and maturity when this batch (current UG Semester-I) of students move onto their third year of UG study (Semester-V of the UG CBCS system). (6) It was further delineated that the student mentors (starting from the 2019-2020 academic session) will be entrusted with the following responsibilities: (a) To keep a close vigil and to subsequently halt any activity that involves freshmen. Such activities include, but are not limited to: introduction sessions conducted by seniors, either personal or relating to extracurricular activities, which extend beyond acceptable limits of (b) In matters pertaining to academics, which require preventive or curative action to be taken in the interest of the wards, the mentor has the responsibility and the right to bring the case to notice of the concerned Faculty mentor, who would in turn take the necessary action. (c) In matters that affect the wards, and can only be resolved at the college level, the Student Mentors have the right to bring the problem to the notice of the principal, it is however desired that the mentor team works in harmony with the disciplinary committee and various (d) In case of fresher who needs additional help, the Student Mentors shall coordinate with (7) The meeting ended with thanking the chair.
