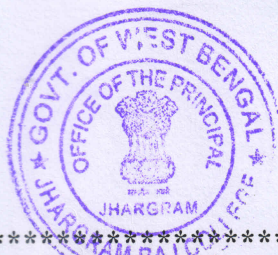

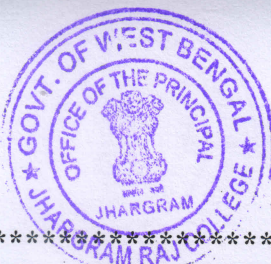

**Important Points to be noted**

- ❖ A formal counselling for the admission in the hostels will be held at 11.00 am dated on 29.11.2023 (Wednesday) in the room no. **CH10** (Dept. of Chemistry). The candidates are advised to be present well in advance in the counselling room along with all the original documents (**Hostel application form, medical fitness certificate from the authorised medical practitioners/Govt. hospital, money receipt for the college admission, distance certificate, mark sheet of the latest qualifying examination and category certificate** (where applicable)).
- ❖ **Physical appearance of the parents/legal guardian of the applicants with identity proof during counselling is mandatory**, otherwise her/his application will be cancelled.
- ❖ Original Hostel application form, original medical fitness certificate from the authorised medical practitioners/Govt. hospital, original distance certificate, self-attested photo copy of the money receipt for the college admission, self-attested photocopy of the mark sheet of the latest qualifying examination and self-attested photocopy of the category certificate (where applicable), self-attested photocopy of the Adhar card and two crossed signed passport size photograph have to be handed over to the dealing officers present during the counselling.

- ❖ Published merit list is only provisional and may be rejected during physical verification of all the documents during the counselling if it is found that there are discrepancy in the information provided or suppression of information in the hostel admission form.
- ❖ After successful counselling, a bank challan will be given to the applicants. Rs. 3395.00 for UG and Rs. 3275.00 for PG candidates will have to be deposited as hostel admission fees in the Axis Bank, Jhargram Branch dated on 29.11.2023.
- ❖ Mess charge is extra and shall be deposited as separately as advance to the hostel standing/mess secretary of the respective hostel. All the mess dues must be cleared before 07<sup>th</sup> of every month to the mess committee.
- ❖ Room will be allotted only after production of payment receipt indicating the successful payment of the hostel admission fees.
- ❖ No boarders are allowed to stay after the completion of his/her final semester examination (maximum two years for PG and maximum four years for UG). Drop out students are also not allowed to stay in the hostels under any circumstances except special medical ground.
- ❖ Accommodating any permanent guest in the room of any boarder is a punishable offence and boardership will be cancelled for any boarder found guilty of accommodating permanent guesthis/her room under any circumstances.
- ❖ The hostels will remain close during the **entire SUMMER, PUJA and WINTER vacations** and the boarders have to vacate their room immediately after the notification of such vacations. Forcefully staying during such vacation will be treated as illegal and the college authority may take legal action against such activities.
- ❖ The candidates are directed to bring **dishes/plate, bowl, glass, broom, bucket, mug, bedding, lock & key** etc. and other necessary things of his/her own. Hostel authority will provide one cot, one mattress, one chair and one table only.
- ❖ Rules and regulation mentioned in the **admission form** will be followed strictly.
